Arranging traffic in the pedestrian zone of the peninsula

- Sustainable Urban Logistics Study has been developed for the Peninsula area
- Analyses of the impact of implemented measures
- NEW REGULATION obtained "Decision on Determination and Arrangement of Traffic in the Pedestrian zone of the Peninsula",
- Started applying new measures







Implemented measures

- Video surveillance set for monitoring all entrances to the pedestrian zone on the Peninsula
- Load/unload places as an alternative to the repealed afternoon shift (11 points of transfer, retention time 30 min.)
- > The delivery time from 13:00 to 15:00 was terminated
- > Using an electric vehicle with special specifications (0-24)



Next steps to implement for better traffic control

- Due to better traffic regulation in the pedestrian zone, the next step is to set the physical barriers
- Ramps that would work to identify the vehicle or the cards that the delivery company would get to enter the pedestrian zone
- To adjust surveillance system with national regulations to be able to issue fines
